UPCIC: Under Pressure Cut-in Connection

All fields above must be completed and a plan supplied. If not, the application will be **rejected**.

If water quality results are not attached, they must be supplied within **48 hours** of the planned connection. If the results are not supplied the connection will be **cancelled**.

At CWW we have a target for planned interruptions to be completed in less than **150 minutes**. It is our expectation that both consultants and contractors will work with us to decrease the disruption times and thus reduce the impact of works.

In residential areas the shutdown of water mains is normally scheduled for **9am on weekdays**. In industrial and commercial areas the impact on business is considered and it may be necessary to carry out the work outside normal working hours.
